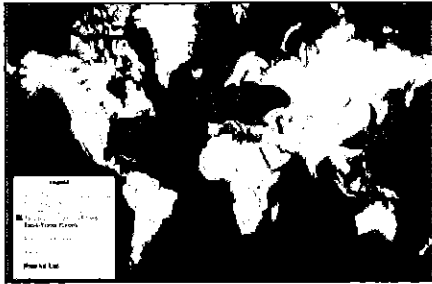

Animal Adaptations: birds migrate south in winter
mammals and insects reduce their activity and do not need as much food for energy (hibernate)

Plant Adaptations: trees shed leaves in winter, herbs seeds, bulbs, rhizomes become dormant. Spring: trees grow new leaves, seeds germinate, rhizomes & roots grow new shrubs and stems
